

Construction Apprenticeships

If you are interested in a future in the Construction Industry and wish to undertake a full apprenticeship, earning a weekly wage and learning a trade, four days a week on site and one day a week at Hull College please carry out the processes outlined below.

Pre - Apprenticeship selection process (16 to 18 years)

Stage 1

Please go and register for the apprenticeship vacancies at our **City Works job shop -26 Princes Dock Street, Hull, Tel 308711**. *(Situated at the back of Princes Quay between Cuckoos coffee bar and the Trinity school).*

Stage 2

Once you have registered at City Works we will arrange for you to sit a CITB entrance test. You will receive a letter confirming the time and place as soon as it can be arranged.

This assessment is done under exam conditions so the time and date we give you is very important, you must arrive in good time to take the test!

You will be notified of your results by post within a few days.

Interview

If you pass the entrance test we will offer you an interview for a place on the Construction Works apprenticeship programme. There may be opportunities to join a pre apprentice course with a training provider if you do not pass the assessment.
